

Lost Children reported by Parents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Immediately report that there is a lost child and your location. ➤ Rovers on both sides of reporting station procede to his/her location. ➤ Stay with parent(s). OK to leave assignment, if necessary. ➤ Report child name, sex, age, clothing description, location last seen to Net Control. See Field Identification Information card. ➤ If parents insist on splitting up, request a second operator before letting them do so. One operator with each parent.
Lost Children reported by Net Control or Police	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Note name, sex, age, clothing, last location. ➤ Be on the look out for child and report if found.
Found Children (lost parents)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Stay with Child. ➤ Report description and location to Net Control. ➤ Stay put until instructed by Net Control. ➤ Go with child if he/she will not stay put.
